

Individual Interview

In addition to the data collected from the Group Conference, an individual may be necessary with certain students who consistently exhibit problem behaviors. The following questions are designed to develop specific strategies to reduce problem behavior.

1. Spend a few moments to acclimate the student to the one-on-one setting. Do not make them feel threatened.
2. Explain what you have observed in class and why that has caused you and other students problems. Do you feel that those observations are inaccurate?
3. How do you feel about the way I handle those behaviors? Is there something I should do differently?
4. How can we work together and create a system or strategy to eliminate that behavior in the classroom? Do you think we can encourage others to reduce problem behaviors as well?
